The banks of South Llano River will be the scene this year for the **Fourth Annual Oktoberfisch**, a festival of fly-fishing. Based at Morgan Shady Park on the Beautiful South Llano River in Junction Texas, the festival offers fly fishing enthusiasts of all levels a venue to come together and enjoy a weekend of comraderie, education, kayaking and fly fishing in the cool, crystal clear waters of the South Llano River.

Festival activities include:

- Beginner fly casting classes
- Advanced fly casting classes with Al Crise & Stacy Trimble
- Kayak and canoe shuttles and kayak games
- Stream side educational programs and lectures
- Exhibitor booths with Orvis, Wilderness Systems Kayaks and others.
- Tent camping and RV camping on the lush grounds at the festival site
- Streamside campfires on Friday night and Saturday night
- Rib Eye steak dinner catered on Saturday evening
- Shuttles to three locations for kayaks, canoes and wade fishing.
- The always popular Raffle that last year included items such as a guided float trip, several top of the line fly rods and reels from Orvis and others and many other great prizes.





Participants receive a registration packet that will include an assortment of flies popular on the river and other goodies. Tent camping on the lush lawn under towering old Pecan trees is included in the entry fee. For those who delight in Texas fly fishing

while leisurely enjoying one of the crowning jewels of Texas rivers the members of the Fredericksburg Fly Fishers invite you to join us on the weekend of October 19th, 20th and 21st for the **Fourth Annual Oktoberfisch.**

Last years festival was fantastic with over one hundred and thirty participants attending. This year we have a new location that offers lush green grass, huge pecan trees for shade, restrooms, showers, RV spaces with hookups and more all situated right next to the South Llano River.
